**RE: NSPCC'S 'CLOSE THE LOOPHOLE' CAMPAIGN.**

Thank you for your recent correspondence in respect of the safety and protection of young people, specifically about people in positions of trust; your comments upon which I have read with great interest.

I share your concerns about this hugely important issue, and I agree that the protection of children and young people must remain a priority. I'd like to take this opportunity to pay tribute to those who have spoken out about child sexual abuse.

As I am sure you are aware, sexual activity with a child under the age of 16 is a serious criminal offence, regardless of whether consent is given. It is also the case that any non-consensual sexual activity is a crime. It doesn't matter the age of the victim, or the relationship between the victim and the perpetrator. I understand it is also the case that where a manipulative offender grooms a child under the age of consent and then engages in a sexual relationship with them when they are over 16, offences are in place to deal with this such as Section 15A of the *Sexual Offences Act 2003*.

I welcome the fact that the *Sexual Offences Act 2003* also provides increased protection for younger people aged 16 and 17. Offences criminalise those in a position of trust who sexually abuse young people in their care. The offences target relationships where the young person has some dependency on the adult involved and often combined with an element of vulnerability of that young person.

I am glad that the Government has committed to change the law around 'positions of trust' in the *Sexual Offences Act 2003*. I shall continue to work closely with the Government to ensure sports coaches are included as part of these legislative changes.

I understand your frustrations about timescales, but I hope this reassures you that the Government is committed to doing all it can to protect children and young people.
