I am writing to outline and firmly associate myself with the local objections expressed by my constituents in respect of the above planning application. Please find enclosed multiple objection letters from residents that have been shared with me, organised by their local councillor, Dorothy Maxwell.

I must say that, historically, residents that live on Scarborough Street have consistently raised the already extremely concerning present situation in relation to highway safety, congestion and parking that occurs - even prior to the suggestion of the addition of more properties in this location.

Indeed, the proximity of multiple significant sized schools in the immediate vicinity, in conjunction with an already overcrowded residential parking situation, means that at peak times there are an extremely large number of vehicles, in addition to children and parents all struggling to access and traverse Scarborough Street. This has in turn led to real safety concerns being raised in the context of this application, not least about larger vehicles, such as emergency services vehicles, that need to safely access this part of the town without incident.

Residents remain very concerned that an area that is already highly congested will be irreversibly impacted by the addition of this large number of concentrated properties, with the inevitable accompanying vehicles and access requirements this will entail - and without a credible plan to address this.

On these grounds, I wish to associate myself with the objections raised by local residents and urge that local wishes be respected and this application be refused.
