All staff in the DWP undergo Public Sector Equality Duty (PSED) training. PSED training is provided to ensure that all DWP staff have the right level of skill and understanding to ensure the equality of treatment for all customers.

Moreover, all fraud investigations are conducted in line with current legislation, including the *Regulation of Investigatory Powers Act 2000* and the *Police & Criminal Evidence Act 1984*.
